Painter

The Springfield Museums has an immediate opening for a painter, this is a three month, temporary, 25-29 hour per week position, Monday through Friday. There is a possibility that this position will be extended.

Responsibilities include performing a variety of painting related functions to primarily maintain the interior of building which includes: removal of old paint; washing, sanding or otherwise smoothing and preparing surfaces; filling holes, cracks, etc. with patching plaster or putty; mixing/blending paints and stains to desired color and consistency; and paint wood, metal, plaster and other surfaces of interior walls and trim, floors, etc.

A High School diploma or GED is required along with a minimum of three years prior experience. Knowledge of painting and painting preparation methods with the ability to use various painting options including brush, roller and spray equipment is required. The ability to read and understand work requests, schedules, diagrams and other comparable data is necessary.

Applicant will be required to provide professional reference. Upon offer of employment, the applicant will be required to pass a CORI check.
