SAFARI Viewers



These DIY viewers will help you zero in on signs of animal life in your own neighborhood!

You will need:

Two toilet paper tubes
Tape
Hole punch
Yarn, about 30 inches

Optional:

Crayons
Markers
Stickers
Other materials for decorating

1. Hold the two tubes together.
2. Wrap tape around one end of the tubes, binding them together. Repeat at the opposite end.
3. At one end of the tubes, punch one hole on the outer right and the outer left.
4. Tie one end of the yarn through the right hole and one on the left.
5. You can decorate your viewer however you like using crayons, markers, or stickers.

Your viewers are now ready to help you focus on objects during your neighborhood safari!
