



## Storm King Art Center New Windsor, NY Monday, June 12

**7:45 am** - Park and board the bus in the State Street parking lot located directly across from the Springfield Main Library. **8 am** - Departure from the State Street parking lot.

Enjoy a guided highlights tour of Storm King on foot and via tram. Storm King's permanent collection of sculpture, dating from 1945 to the present, includes works by many of the twentieth century's most influential artists, integrated into a pristine, 500-acre landscape of rolling hills, fields, and woodlands.

Among the park's signature pieces are Louise Nevelson's *City on the High Mountain* (1983), geometric shapes painted black; one of Alexander Calder's last monumental stabiles, *The Arch* (1975); an untitled work by Robert Grosvenor (1969), a site-specific structure mimicking the sloping landscape; several monumental steel I-beam sculptures by Mark di Suvero; Andy Goldsworthy, *Five Men, Seventeen Days, Fifteen Boulders, One Wall*, 2010; and *Wavefield* by Maya Lin covering a four-acre site out of earth and grass.

The most recent permanent addition is a site-specific sculpture *Fallen Sky* by artist Sarah Sze (b. 1969, Boston, US). An art exhibition of the same name will flow from two indoor gallery spaces out into the landscape beyond, leading the visitor from the exhibition towards an overlook to Storm King's breathtaking south expanse, and to the site of the 36-foot-round *Fallen Sky*, framed by the mountains beyond.

**12:45 pm** – Enjoy a picnic lunch at the Center's Cafe. Please choose from the following:

- Hummus, cabbage slaw with lemon and olives on whole wheat wrap
- Sliced smoked turkey & arugula with tarragon-mayo on whole wheat baguette
- Salami, provolone, sweet and spicy peppers, and lettuce on whole wheat baguette
- Mozzarella, pesto, tomatoes & arugula on whole wheat baguette.

***Includes potato chips and bottled water.***

Following lunch, explore on your own. Trams run approximately every 30 minutes. Visitors may disembark, walk, and re-board at designated points throughout the grounds. Tram stops are indicated on the map and guide.

**3 pm** – Meet the bus at our drop off point and depart for Springfield with an estimated return by 5:30 pm.

**What to bring:** Camera, comfortable walking shoes, hat (sun protection), water and snacks for the bus.
